

The Kastania Tank project is complete. Built in 1985 and located just south of Petaluma, the Kastania Tank plays a vital role for both North Marin and Marin Municipal Water Districts, holding an impressive 12 million gallons!

Our crew kicked off this project in June 2023. Fast forward 14 months and, after a thorough update replacing parts, preventing corrosion and giving the tank a fresh coat inside and out, we're now refilling it with nearly 37 acre-feet of water from the Petaluma Aqueduct!



Construction crews are on site at Washington Creek in Petaluma for proactive emergency repairs including part of the flood channel retaining wall that needed reinforcement. Work to rebuild this segment of the wall will continue for a couple of weeks, and is planned to be complete before the start of the rainy season.

This engineered channel was originally constructed in the 1970s.
