


2025 Workplan

GOALS

- Increase capacity of water sector Safety Assessment Program certified staff. (Q1)
- 2. Practice interagency communications and coordination specific to occurrence of unsafe drinking water conditions. (Q2)
- 3. Conduct a SW Earthquake Impacts Assessment & Resiliency Workshop. (Q3)
- 4. Develop a SW/Water Contractors Earthquake Response Concept of Operations outlining interagency communications and coordination during seismic events. (Q4)
- 5. Maintain regular forum of discussion to identify immediate needs or areas for improvement.







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
