Sonoma Water - Teacher Checklist - 5th Grade Water Education Program

Before your pre-lesson visit:

- Visit our pre-lesson website links.
- Watch salmon life cycle video and water system video.
- Watch the <u>"What to expect video"</u> with the students

Before your field trip:

- Recruit chaperones (minimum 1 chaperone per 7 students)
- Send out the <u>chaperone letter and map to the water education center</u>
 - At least one chaperone will need to drive their personal car to the site.
 - All chaperones that drive, need to follow the bus from the school to enter the field study site.
- Remind students:

What to wear?

- Appropriate clothes for being outdoors most of the day (pants, no shorts)
- Sturdy walking shoes
- Rain jacket or poncho (if rain is a possibility)

What to bring?

- o Bring a Day Pack
- o At least one water bottle full of water A morning snack and lunch
- Sunscreen and or hat / hats

Day of the field trip:

Teacher Expectations:

- Bring signed permission slips.
- o Place name tags on students (divide each class into two equal groups).
- Bring student field journals and pencils (pass out journals before arrival)
- Make sure your students are prepared for the day.
- Extra masks and sanitizer (we will also provide both)
- Ensure students and chaperones adhere to Covid-19 guidelines. Sonoma Water staff will help, but we
 will look to teachers and chaperones to lead.

Chaperone expectations:

- 1. Assist students with following safety rules.
- 2. Help manage snack, lunch, and restroom breaks.
- 3. Support student engagement during educational activities.
- 4. Wear appropriate clothing for being outdoors and hiking on uneven terrain.
- 5. No other children or pets are allowed on the field trip.
- 6. Follow Covid school and field trip protocols.
